

Construction Activity Notice #16

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) is in the process of improving the Hyannis Transportation Center site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.

Dates: Week of April 29, 2019

Work Hours: Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.

Work Activity: Electrical subcontractor will have ongoing electrical work within the fenced in area, including trenching for conduit and setting light post base. In addition, solar construction activities will continue throughout the week. Contractor will be grading the area under the canopy and surrounding area. Contractor will be setting curbs in the east lot, with sidewalk work to follow. Contractor will be grading sidewalks under bus canopy area, as well as areas directly north and east of the HTC building.

Important Note: The major construction activity at the Hyannis Transportation Center will be completed in the near future and the CCRTA will be reinstating parking fees in accordance with CCRTA's published parking rates. The CCRTA will provide two weeks advance notice regarding the date parking fees will be reinstated.

Impact to Riders: This phase of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have some impact to pedestrian and bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
