

Construction Activity Notice #19

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) is in the process of improving the Hyannis Transportation Center site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.

Dates: Week of May 20, 2019

Work Hours: Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.

Work Activity: Contractor will be setting curb (5/20). Contractor will be paving future short-term lot (5/21). Contractor will be applying pavement markings and lot expected to be open this day with a time to be determined (5/22). Contractor will be completing the remainder of concrete work, including sidewalks in the vicinity of the HTC building (5/23). Contractor will be completing small odds and ends throughout the site, as well as preparing the area for the upcoming Memorial Day weekend (5/24). Separate contractor will be installing electrical vehicle charging stations in various locations on the HTC site (5/20 – 5/24).

Important note: All employees and passengers must use concrete walkway when traveling to and from buses with no access permitted in the paved bus area. Parking fees were reinstated on May 20, 2019 in accordance with CCRTA's published parking rates.

Impact to Riders: This phase of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have some impact to pedestrian and bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
