

# Construction Activity Notice #2

*The Hyannis Transportation Center is preparing to improve our site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.*

**Dates:** Week of January 21, 2019

**Work Hours:** Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.

**Work Activity:** Phase 1 of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will continue through the remainder of the month and will impact the area directly to the north of the Gate 9A and 9B bus passenger loading area, with some periodic disruption directly related to Gate 9B. The Gate 10 (Sandwich Line), was relocated to the west side of the Hyannis Transportation Center terminal on Transportation Avenue (signage will be posted). Currently, there is ongoing earthwork, drainage and utility work within the fenced in construction area, with a temporary pedestrian walk area outside of the construction fence provided. This area will be “lined” with rope and orange construction posts.

**Impact to Riders:** Phase 1 of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have minimal impact to pedestrian or bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
