

Construction Activity Notice #4

The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) is in the process of improving the Hyannis Transportation Center site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.

Dates: Week of February 4, 2019

Work Hours: Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.

Work Activity: Construction work continues in fenced-in area where temporary construction fence and temporary pedestrian walkway outside of the construction fence is located. Construction activity includes the completion of grading work and applying a paving “binder coat” in the fenced in construction area. After completion, the contractor will be breaking down the fence and moving construction activities to the short-term parking lot. Contractor will be putting up a temporary construction fence in Short-Term Parking Lot that will encompass the work area. Construction work includes earthwork and some drainage and utility work within the fenced-in area. In addition, contractor will provide a temporary pedestrian walkway from the Long-Term Parking Lot through the Short-Term Parking Lot to the concrete walkway marked with construction posts and yellow rope. Signage will be posted.

IMPORTANT NOTE: SHORT-TERM PARKING LOT WILL BE CLOSED FROM 2/5/19 THROUGH 2/22/19 – PARKING IS MOVED TO LONG-TERM EAST LOT FOR THIS CLOSURE PERIOD.

Impact to Riders: This phase of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have some impact to pedestrian and bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
