

# Construction Activity Notice #7

*The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) is in the process of improving the Hyannis Transportation Center site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.*

**Dates: Week of February 25, 2019**

**Work Hours: Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.**

**Work Activity: Construction work will continue to take place in the Short-Term Parking Lot; a portion of the bus circle; canopy area and an expanded area of the concrete walkway adjacent to the railroad tracks. The “exit” side of the bus circle will remain closed off until 2/25/19 and will reopen on 2/26/19. The fenced-in area in the Short-Term Parking Lot will have additional earthwork, paving, drainage and utility work. The temporary pedestrian walkway from the Long-Term East Parking Lot through the Short-Term Parking Lot along the railroad fence line will be closed and relocated to the opposite side along the one-way portion of Transportation Avenue. The moved walkway will be marked with new yellow pavement markings and signage. In addition, the eastern half of the long-term parking lot (railroad yard side) will be closed and fenced off for construction activities. The other half of the parking lot will remain open for FREE public parking while construction activity is taking place. Employee parking will continue to be located in the Long-Term West Lot closest to Transportation Avenue until further notice. Bus canopy area to be relocated to newly paved area. New yellow pavement markings and signage will be in place, including “gate numbering”. Buses departing from the depot will back out towards Transportation Avenue and will make the maneuver around the pond to exit via**

the newly hard-packed road. Bus canopy and related passenger loading area will be fenced off from 2/26/19 to 3/1/19 so that the existing structures can be demolished.

**Impact to Riders:** This phase of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have some impact to pedestrian and bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
