

# Construction Activity Notice #9

*The Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority (CCRTA) is in the process of improving the Hyannis Transportation Center site to better serve our patrons. The CCRTA will be providing regular updates of any alternate pedestrian and/or bus patterns on our website and social media, as well as posted signs throughout the Hyannis Transportation Center property.*

**Dates: Week of March 11, 2019**

**Work Hours: Work activity will occur in the hours covering 7 AM to 7 PM.**

**Work Activity:** The fenced-in area in the Short-Term Parking Lot will have additional earthwork, paving, drainage and utility work. The area encompassing the north and east side of the HTC building will have drainage, grading, and utility work. The pedestrian walkway and bus loading area along the one-way portion of Transportation Avenue is marked and includes signage. The solar canopy installers have mobilized in the eastern half of the long-term parking lot (railroad yard side) and will begin construction activities. The other half of the parking lot will remain open for FREE public parking while construction activity is taking place. Contractor will be “trenching” a water line through the middle of the bus circle area. This will necessitate a closure of this area to bus traffic of approximately 1-hour (day and time to be determined and will be announced in advance).

Employee parking will continue to be located in the Long-Term West Lot closest to Transportation Avenue until further notice. New bus passenger loading area - bus traffic flow reminder: Buses departing from the depot will back out towards Transportation Avenue and will make the maneuver around the pond to exit via the newly hard-packed road.

**Impact to Riders:** This phase of the Hyannis Transportation Center construction activity will have some impact to pedestrian and bus traffic. Any disruptions that may arise from this phase of the construction project will be posted and communicated through the CCRTA Information Booth public announcements.
